

EMERGENCY SHELTER PROGRAM

The Lighthouse operates an overnight, year-round Emergency Shelter Program serving 50 adults and 8 youth (age 16-24). Anyone seeking emergency shelter can drop in or call our intake line: 705-329-2265 ext 1 for Adult Shelter ext 2 for Youth Shelter. If seeking Emergency Shelter, the call or visit must be from the person seeking emergency shelter. The Lighthouse uses a diversion and triage model to register our most vulnerable individuals first.

Emergency Shelter Program services can be accessed from a variety of sources including self-referral, EMS (Emergency Medical Services), community partner referrals, and institutional discharge planning through hospitals, Correctional Services and other facilities. Our staff work with Participants to develop housing goals and plans. We assist to facilitate access to support wellness, medical needs, housing, spiritual well-being, ID and other community support services to ultimately exit our program into safe housing in the community.

DAILY CLOSURES

+ EXTREME WEATHER

Our indoor program spaces have daily closures. December 1-April 1 -1:30pm-3:30pm & April 1- December 1 1:30pm- 4:30pm . During this time registered Emergency Shelter Program Participants are invited to use our grounds to get fresh air and exercise. Our washrooms remain open to registered participants for use as needed and to the public in an emergency. Participants are encouraged to use this time to view housing, attend community appointments & use alternative city Warming Centres. Our indoor space closures are necessary to do daily cleaning of public spaces used by 58+ people daily. The remaining 21 hours per day we are open and operating, 7 days per week. If Environment Canada issues an extreme weather warning, The Lighthouse Cafe/Atrium services will stay open to allow registered shelter program participants access.

The Orillia Overnight Warming Centre operates as a life-saving measure for the purpose of providing shelter to marginalized people who are experiencing homelessness and may also suffer from issues related to substance use, mental health, physical and/or cognitive disabilities and other issues related to poverty and marginalization.

People looking to access services are invited to drop in **Mon - Fri, 9:00a - 2:00p.** The Lighthouse Community *Brief Services* are listed on the next page and are offered by appointment between 2:00p - 4:00p, Mon - Fri.

Visitors should ring the buzzer at the front door to be let in. This is a controlled entry, please do not allow entry to someone waiting or come in behind another person/visitor.

MOTEL VOUCHER

PROGRAM (MVP)

The Lighthouse is an administrator for this County of Simcoe Program in Orillia, primarily developed to address the gap in Simcoe County's emergency shelter services for families. Since individuals and couples generally have the option of staying in emergency shelters located throughout the county, families (individuals with dependents) who meet the criteria may be provided with a motel voucher on an "exception" basis only.

The MVP has unique eligibility requirements, maximum day(s) per calendar year and some may be turned away based on ineligibility, service restrictions, vacancies or safety concerns. Evenings and Saturdays response times may be delayed. Access 8a - 4p, Mon - Fri.



SUPPORTIVE HOUSING BUILDING

Supportive Housing is a separate program.

Registration for this program is facilitated by The County of Simcoe via Coordinated Access.

The Lighthouse offers computer, internet, phone & fax use in 30-minute increments for housing, employment and educational needs.

TEXTILE DONATIONS

The community's textile donations are vital to our operations however, The Lighthouse is not a clothing access point. We do not give clothing to the public or receive clothing donations en mass at our facility. We have community partners that operate as our warehouse for bulk clothing, essentials and food too! This model is effectively knocking down silos and represents a community working at its finest through collaboration. We ask that you continue to donate to the organizations listed in this guide to help us easily access and store supplies to best fill our participant's needs.

We do use seasonal drives to collect needed items and we invite donors to visit our website for most needed items that change seasonally. These items may be collected off-site or on location depending on the need and item. Visit our website to view our greatest monthly needs list.

Registered Emergency Shelter & Community Program Participants can meet with paramedics by appointment on-site to help improve quality of life and well-being. This reduces patient exacerbations and crises requiring 911 response, emergency department visits and hospital admissions. Paramedics also collaborate with patients' family doctors reducing the need for clinic visits.

Registered Emergency Shelter & Community Program Participants who meet The Lighthouse criteria without a family doctor may make an appointment to see a doctor or nurse practitioner for physical health support on-site. Our medical experts use a triage model to consider our most vulnerable individuals first. Appointments are subject to availability.

Pre-approved food donations can be dropped off Mon - Fri, 9am - 6pm and Sat - Sun, 1pm - 4pm. A Kitchen team member can help to receive your donation at the right side of our Community Services Building at the kitchen door. Please ring the doorbell for service. Our shelter worker staff are not available to receive food donations after hours.

The Lighthouse works with the Sharing Place Food Centre to secure menu items. It is encouraged that all non-perishable food donations be redirected to them when our kitchen is not open.

The Lighthouse also fills registered Participant bulk orders to meet any onsite emergency needs outside of individualized orders being completed. All clothing needs to be new or gently used. It needs to be washed and put into a clear bag for sanitary and safety reasons.

Clothing items accepted: coats/jackets, t-shirts, long sleeve shirts, sweatshirts, hoodies, jeans, shorts, comfy pants, pajamas, work boots, running shoes and winter boots. Donations of slippers, socks and underwear (children & adult) must be new for hygienic reasons. 


